

## What is a school report?

At the end of the school year, the pupils receive a school report. Normally the school report contains the grades. But in the 1st and 2nd school years, the pupils do not receive any grades. Instead they receive a written report from their class teacher.

The school report describes three areas relating to the child's:

- behaviour
- working
- learning.

### • Behaviour

How does the child behave towards the teachers?

How does the child behave towards the other pupils?

How does the child handle the school materials?

Is the child considerate and helpful?

Is the child friendly and polite?

### • Working

Does the child have stamina?

Is the child attentive? Does the child work carefully?

Is the child able to work independently?

### • Learning

What has the child already learned?

Does the child enjoy learning? Does he/she learn quickly? easily?

From the school report, parents can see how their child behaves in school and how he/she has developed. If the assessments seem to be unreasonable for the parents, they can ask for a meeting with the teacher.
